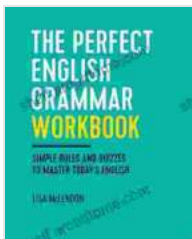

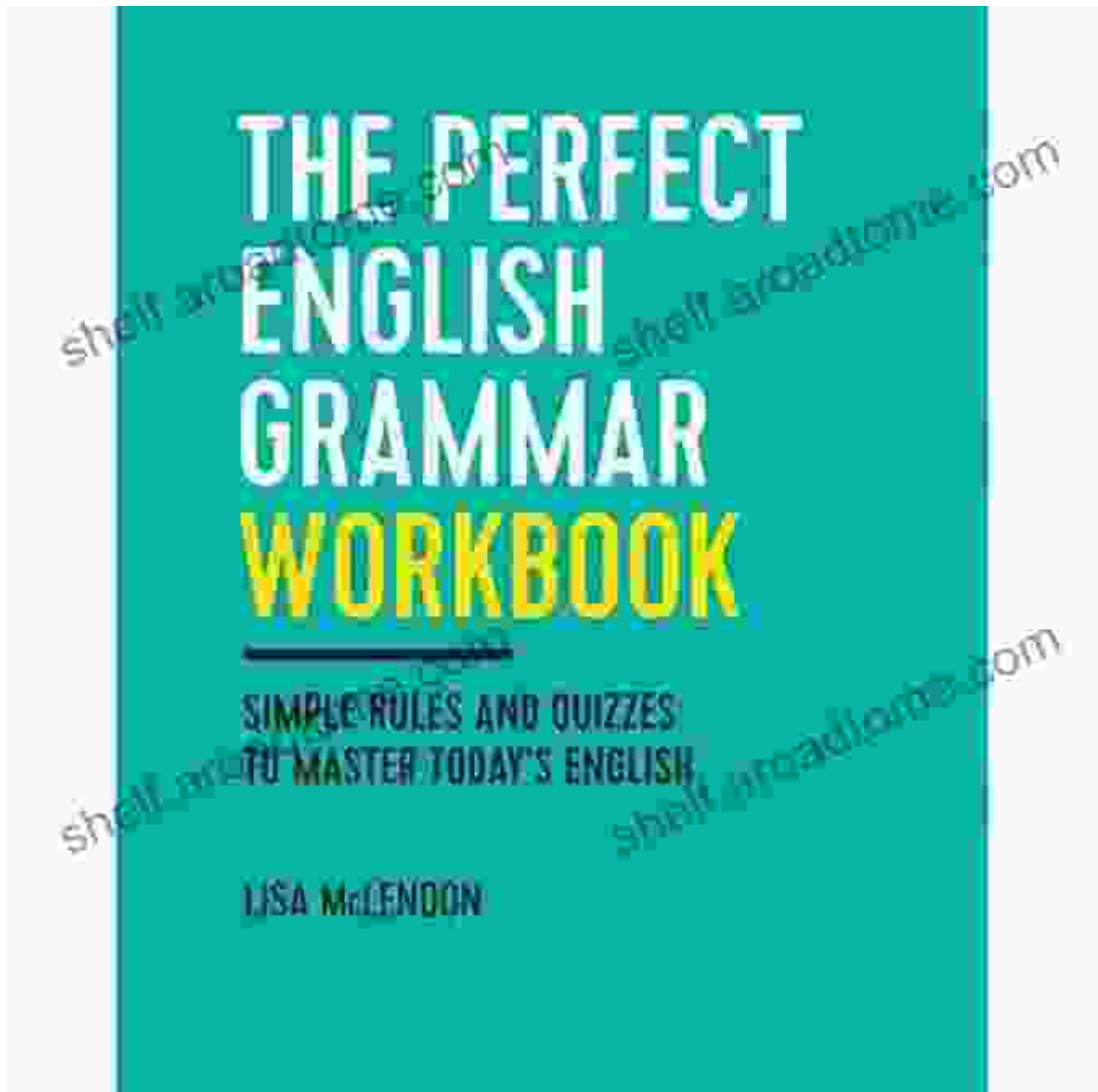
A list of five of the most common grammatical mistakes:

- 2 Possessive Nouns**
Non-native speakers of the English are unsure about showing possession while writing or speaking in English.
For example: 'The book belonging to the girl' can also be referred to as 'The girl's book'.
- 3 Comparison of Adjectives**
We add 'er' to compare short adjectives like pretty and thick; and we add 'more' for longer adjectives like handsome and intelligent.
- 4 Punctuation Mistakes**
Punctuation errors, too, are very common, especially in the use of semicolons and commas.
- 5 Singular and Plural**
Many new learners make mistakes in forming the plural form of singular nouns.
